Dear Titan Parent / Guardian:

I hope this letter finds you and your students enjoying a restful winter break!

If you have students who drive to school, or if you choose to drop off and pick up your student at school, you are well aware of the limitations of our parking lot. With only one entrance and exit, arriving to the building just before 8 a.m. or leaving around 3 p.m. is a definite challenge. **Because the safety of our students and guests is of utmost concern for us, we want to remind you of the parking lot flow and drop-off and pick-up procedure.**

Most of our students are provided with bus transportation. While we recognize that some parents choose (or at times find it absolutely necessary) to drive their students to school, we are asking everyone to limit the use of this option as much as possible. If your student is provided transportation, please encourage him/her to use it.

If you find it necessary to drive, please see the map included with this letter and keep the following expectations in mind:

- ◆ First and foremost, please drive slowly and cautiously in the parking lot, always watching for students walking between parked cars!
- ◆ All students that begin their day at **7 a.m.** will only have access to the building through **door S6**, in the back of the building adjacent to the cafeteria, beginning at 6:30 a.m.
- ◆ **The school building will not be open until 6:30 a.m.** If you drive your student to school, please drop him/her off at door S6 **after** 6:30 a.m.
- ◆ Door W1 (the visitor's entrance) will be open for guests and students by 7:15 a.m.
- All traffic entering the lot must use the two lanes at the far west end of the parking lot (see map).
- All traffic must proceed around the entire perimeter of the lot in the lanes provided for pick-up and drop-off purposes; **DO NOT CUT THROUGH OPEN PARKING SPACES.**
- Students can be dropped off or picked up near door S8, S6, S1, or W1. These doors are labeled on the map and an "X" marks the location of the parking lot near those doors.
- To eliminate confusion, talk to your student about which location would be best to pick up and drop off.
- Pull up to the curb to pick up and drop off; **DO NOT DOUBLE PARK OR STOP IN TRAFFIC.**
- The two lanes closest to the building on the west end are one-way from south to north. Vehicles turning right onto 175th Street should only use the right lane and vehicles turning left should only use the left lane.

Our intention for this letter is to alleviate the congestion on 175th Street, decrease confusion in the lot, and, most importantly, provide a safer environment for everyone.

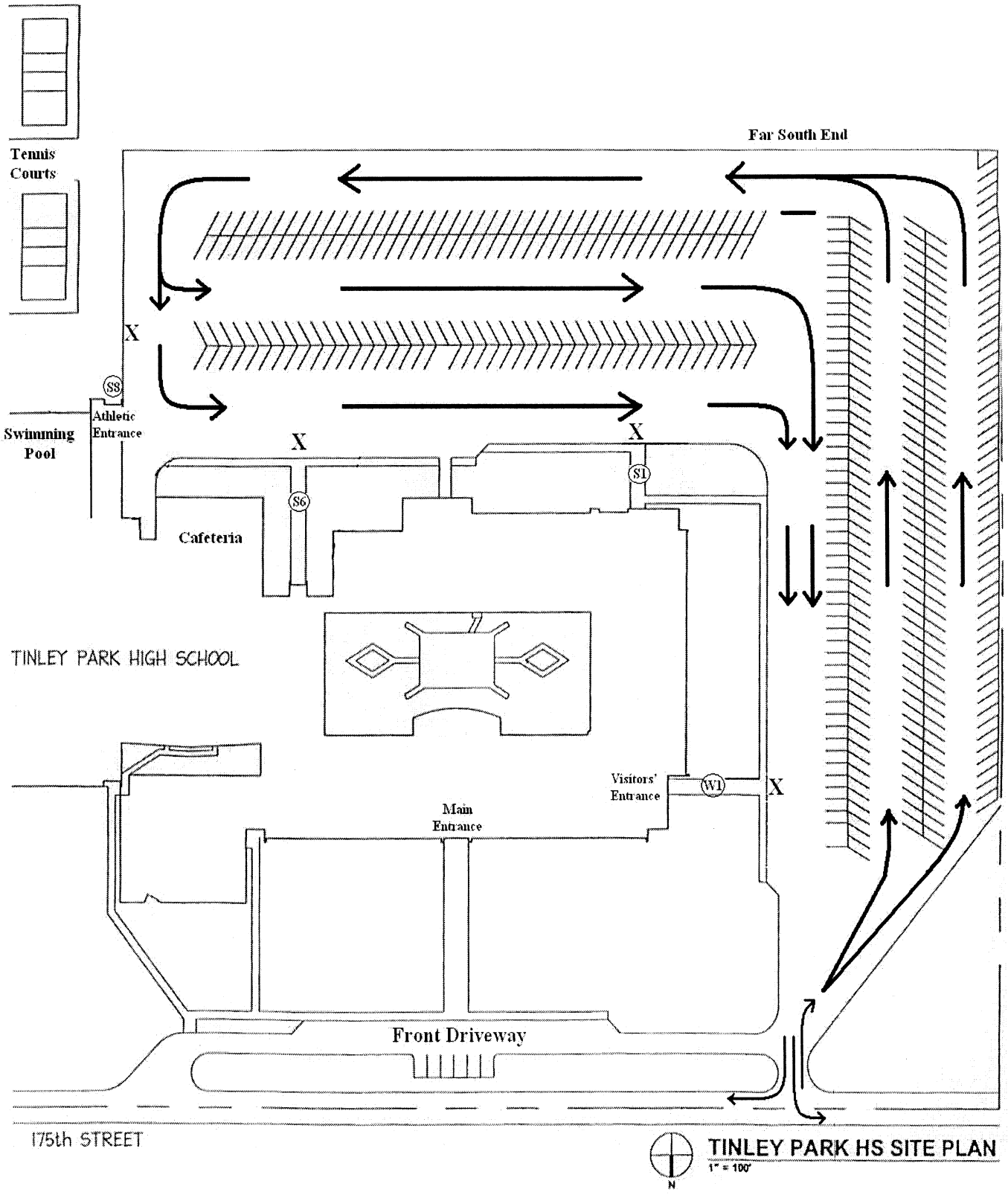
